

- 2. The sanction of the President is also accorded to the release of Rs.10,10,200/- (Rupees Ten LacTen Thousand Two Hundred Only) to the MGM Institute of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai, Maharashtra 410209 being the first installment of grant for implementation of the above mentioned project.
