# **Introduction:**

A cleft and Craniofacial Surgery unit was started at MGM Hospital, Kamothe in partnership with Inga health Foundation and MGM Institute of Health Sciences (MGMIHS) in order to cater to the large patient population of Rural areas adjoining Mumbai and Navi Mumbai, who are not able to access these facilities easily.

The Project was possible due to generous funding from TATA Trust.

MOU between MGMIHS and Inga health Foundation was signed in September 2015 and the first case was operated on 3rd September 2015.

Till Date 720 plus patients have undergone successful surgeries over 10 plus districts of Maharashtra , completely free of cost.

# **Aims and Objectives:**

- To identify and mobilize all patients born with Cleft and Craniofacial Deformities to MGMIHS.
- To carry out educational programs in order to create awareness about the above mentioned deformities, with emphasis on preventive aspects to expecting mothers.
- To do high quality research in this field to find new preventive and treatment strategies.
- To provide patients with specialist consultation in the fields of Surgery, Anaesthesia, Paediatrics, ENT; all free of cost.
- To provide all patients with comprehensive services like Dentistry, Nutrition, Speech Therapy and Orthodontics; all free of cost.
- To make the center sustainable and to take care of the huge burden of care, training facilities for Surgeons and Anaesthesiologist from across the globe will be launched, especially to build skilled human resource in areas of great need.

# **Facilities provided at MGMIHS :**

All the below facilities are offered to the patients completely free of cost.

To and Fro transportation fares as per the state transport department for patient and parent.

Lodging and food to patient and one parent if patient above 5 years' age and two parents if below 5 years of age, in general wards.

Free surgery including all the medicines, surgical materials and Operating room charges.

Comprehensive care which includes Dental and Orthodontic treatment, Nutritional counselling for malnourished infants, Speech therapy sessions for all cleft palate patients.

Other incidentals like Paediatric Intensive care unit, Blood Bank, etc.

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# Center Activities 2015-2016

USA and MGM Institute of health Sciences, Kamothe, Navi Mumbai for children and adults suffering from Cleft lip palate and other congenital facial anomalies on 31st July 2016 at Jede Bhagat Hospital, Baramati. During this camp, 35 patients were screened by Dr Gaurav Deshpande( Oral Maxillofacial Surgeon ) with Aasis Banerjee (Patient Recruitment Manager ) Inga Health Foundation, Mumbai. During this program the first citizen of Baramati, Yogesh Jagtap, President Elec of IMA, Maharashtra State, Dr Ashok Tambe, President of Baramati branch, Dr Dhopade, along with other dignitaries from IMA were present. The patients that were selected by the doctors, traveled to MGM Hospital Navi Mumbai and received necessary corrective Surgery free of cost. The patients were brought to the hospital in batches of people living in nearby villages for convenience and safety. The patients were also entitled to comprehensive care like Dental, Orthodontic corrections, Speech therapy and nutrition as per the need. We look forward to many more such initiatives with the help of IMA, Maharashtra state branch to reach out to more underprivileged children of the state



We have Completed 720 plus Cleft Lip and Palate.. A small story of our 50th case :



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#### STORIES:



1) Gunjan a three day old baby resident of ulashnagar was brought to the Cleft and Craniofacial unit at MGM Hospital, Kamothe, Navi Mumbai for treatment of cleft lip and palate by her parents. Gunjan was the lucky child who was brought to the Cleft care at the right time to get the treatment at right age. The patient was a perfect candidate for NAM (Nasoalveolar moulding) which is carried out prior to the surgery till the age of 6months for better esthetic results. Unfortunately, the parents could not spare time to follow up regularly which is required for the conventional NAM technique. So, an unconventional NAM technique of just lip taping and Nasal hook was carried out. We could get significant results with this procedure and the patient was ready for the surgery. The surgery went on uneventfully and Gunjan is ready with her new smile. Gujan now enjoys normal life with her sister!!!

We wish Gunjan all the very best. She will be treated for cleft palate at age of 1year. THANK YOU TEAM FOR SPREADING

**2) Manali kavate** was born with unilateral cleft lip palate in a place called Uran, a suburban area of Mumbai . She was the first child in her family who was born with such deformity . The parents were unable to understand her condition. Manali struggled for survival as she could not take breast feeds and parents were not counseled for feeding the baby with such condition . She was brought to the Inga Health Foundations's Maaya Cleft and Craniofacial unit at MGM College and Hospital Navi Mumbai when she was 6 months old. Manali was underweight for operating cleft lip surgery. The family had lost hopes of that their child would have a normal smile .The mother was counseled for nutrition and feeding position and shown the pictures of previously operated cases , within 2 months Manali had gained appropriate weight to perform surgical procedure.She was operated for cleft lip surgery and when she was 1 yr old fro cleft palate surgery. Now the family is happy to have healthy Manali smiling like other children and living a normal life .

**3) Aryan Harad** was born as first child to his parents . He lives in Shahapur in Thane district. Aryan was born with Unilateral Cleft lip and Cleft palate.. Aryan's family approached the local hospitals near by for getting the condition treated but the local doctors did not have enough knowledge to treat the condition. Aryans parents came across our Cleft and Craniofacial screening camp through an educational pamphlet from the primary health center, when Aryan was 4 months old. Without wasting time they got their baby Screened in the camp and soon visited our Centre at MGM College and Hospital Kamothe Navi Mumbai for further counseling , Aryan would often suffer from cold and cough which was making him difficult to get fit for the surgery. FinallyAryan was operated when he was 7 months and Cleft Palate Surgery at 1 yr . His family is happy to see him grow and smile like other kids.

**4) Shravan Palvi** was born with cleft lip palate defect in the district Solapur. He was a one day old child who was brought for screening at the camp site organized by Inga health foundation (IHF) in Solapur. The parents and family members were completely disheartened with the birth of the child having such a defect, as he was the first child to his parents .Parents and family members were counselled by the IHF team on board for nutrition , and pictures of pre-post operated cases at the center. Also the Parents saw the patients coming for screening and operated cases as follow-ups in

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the same camp. They could now relate that defect of their child could be completely corrected, shravan could smile and live life like other normal kids .

With the ray of hope in their heart they followed all the pre surgical instructions given to them and the child was fit for lip surgery at the age of 6 months. Shravan was operated fro cleft lip surgery at Maaya Cleft care unit by Inga Health Foundation at Mgm Dental college and Hospital Navi Mumbai. After the surgery was over shravan's father could not control his emotions he went to the operating doctor and thanked him, he opened his heart out by telling how grateful he was that they met the doctor on time in the camp ,was about to abundant the child out of shame ,I was saved from committing a big sin and control my depression.

Soon the family went back with child's new smile and new life. After six months Shravan was operated for cleft palate . Now the family is spreading the message of smile to all the people around .

**5) Sai Pawar baby** of 21 days old born with Cleft lip palate was referred by Being Human Foundation for getting operated at our Maaya Cleft care unit by Inga Health Foundation at Mgm Dental college and Hospital Navi Mumbai. The parents had approached Being Human Foundation as they could not afford the cost of the surgery. Soon the parents were called for nutrition counselling and pre- surgical tissue moulding ( lip taping ) at the centre. They were very motivated after seeing how normal the children looked after being surgically operated. They followed all the instructions given to them till the day of surgery. They were constantly reporting the progress of the baby to the center team through messages and pictures of the baby. The patient underwent lip surgery after 6 months. They got Ahad at the age of 3 months for consultation to IHF center at MGM Dental college and Hospital Navi Mumbai . The family members were counselled by the IHF team on board for nutrition , and pictures of pre-post operated cases at the center, also convinced the grandmother to take care of the child and tell his mother not to neglect the child , the defect would be completely corrected .

child was admitted for lip surgery at the age of 6 months . Ahad was operated for cleft lip surgery at Maaya Cleft care unit by Inga Health Foundation at MGM Dental college and Hospital Navi Mumbai . Ahad's mother has now started accepting her child. It was the first time she had visited the hospital and started taking care of him post surgery. She was in big depression all this while , but after seeing the child post surgery all her worries were gone. Soon Ahad was discharged to go home , he has got his smile as well as love of his mother back . In next six months he will be operated for cleft palate defect .

7) Advay Patil was born with a complete Cleft lip and Palate to his parents in kamothe Navi Mumbai . Advay was first chlid to his parents. The Family came to IHF foundation at MGM kamothe Navi Mumbai through a local contact for consultation. The parents were very apprehensive and had lot of queries regarding the defect and the line of treatment. They had already approached many centers in Mumbai but were not convinced .

When they met one of our previously treated case of cleft lip surgery patient admitted in the ward for cleft palate procedure, they were quite convinced after seeing the result of the previous surgery and talking patient's parents.

Advay's parents got their child operated for cleft lip surgery at the age of 6 months. The family went back with a new smile on Advay's face as well as their own .In next 6 months Advya will get his palate surgery done.

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8)Driti : A 22 days old baby was reported to HF foundation at MGM kamothe Navi Mumbai At with the chief complaint of cleft lip and palate. On extraoral examination- patient had a bilateral cleft of the lip with separated lip segments on both sides , an underdeveloped columella on both sides and depressed nasal bridge and wide nostril base. The premaxilla with the centre of the lip was displaced laterally. The nasal domes were also underdeveloped . A pre operative procedure was done NAM (Naso alveolar moulding) for shaping the pre maxilla and the alveolar ridges for better aesthetic and functional results . this procedure also minimize further corrective surgeries for such patients .
