Rural Health and Training Centre, Ellora

The rural health and training centre under the Department of Community is situated at Ellora in Aurangabad district. It is approximately 28 kilometres from Aurangabad and is also a place of historical importance. The centre caters to population of more than 35,000. It has 6 sub-centres under its direct control. The centre is manned by medical officer, nurses, pharmacist, lab technicians, health workers, sanitary inspector and class IV workers. MGM Medical College, Aurangabad posts interns and resident doctors of OBGY and Paediatrics department to the centre. The interns are posted for a period 15 days in rotation. The resident doctors on rotation basis visit the centre once in a week on fixed days. This centre has outpatient department, in-patient department, laboratory, OT, pharmacy, vaccination room, labour room and meeting room.

There is accommodation facility and food mess facility for students.

The Department of Community Medicine carries out following activities at RHTC, Ellora –

- 1. Posting of interns who provide daily OPD and IPD services to the patients.
- 2. Posting of OBGY resident doctor every Thursday for providing specialist services to expecting mothers and other women.
- 3. Posting of Paediatrics resident every Friday for providing specialist services to the paediatric age group.
- 4. Family Health Surveys.
- 5. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan activities.
- 6. Health Education activities like guidance by specialists, poster exhibition, street plays, counselling sessions, etc.
