
Brief of the Activity : As a part of Swach Bharat Abhyan

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Swachh Survekshan 2018

Introduction:

As a prelude to encouraging cities to improve urban sanitation, Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs (formerly Ministry of Urban Development) had conducted 'Swachh Survekshan-2016' survey for the rating of 73 cities in January 2016 followed by 'Swachh Survekshan-2017' conducted in January- February 2017 ranking 434 cities. MoHUA now proposes to conduct its third survey in the year 2018.¹

The objective of the survey is to encourage large scale citizen participation and create awareness amongst all sections of society about the importance of working together towards making towns and cities a better place to live in. Additionally, the survey also intends to foster a spirit of healthy competition among towns and cities to improve their service delivery to citizens, towards creating cleaner cities.¹

The survey attempts to capture the progress in six broad parameters, including collection and transportation of municipal solid waste, sanitation related progress, and whether cities have started campaigns promoting Swachh Survekshan, engaging citizens in waste management, maintenance of community and public toilets.²

The Swachha-MoHUA is the official app of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), GOI. The app enables a citizen to post a civic-related issue (eg: a garbage dump) which is then forwarded to the city corporation concerned and thereafter assigned to the sanitary inspector of the particular ward.

Planning:

The Panvel City Municipal Corporation (PCMC) had requested assistance from MGM Medical College, Kamothe, to create awareness among citizens of Kamothe, Kalamboli and adjoining areas about Swachh Survekshan 2018. The Department of Community Medicine was entrusted the responsibility by


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Dean Dr. G.S. Narshetty to sensitize citizens about Swachh Survekshan 2018 and the use of Swachhata-MoHUA app, with the help of IInd MBBS students.

Regular meetings were conducted with FCMC officials and a program plan was prepared. Dr. Seema Anjenaya along with Ms. Vineeta Sharma, Health Inspector, trained the IInd year MBBS students about Swachh Survekshan, segregation and disposal of Dry and Wet waste, hazards of improper waste disposal, Composting, use of Swachhata-MoHUA App etc. These trained students would further create awareness about the same to the citizens of Kamothe, Kalamboli and adjoining areas. Relevant banners were made. Format was made to record information about Name of society, name of citizens who attended the sensitization sessions and participating Faculties and MBBS students.

The programme for "Creating awareness among citizens about Swachh Survekshan 2018" was conducted for duration of approximately 3 weeks, starting from...14/01/2018 to 30/1/2018

Approximately 50 second year MBBS students were divided into a group of 4-5 students each. Each group of students were allotted respective Areas/ Sectors/ Buildings/ Societies in Karnothe, Kalamboli and adjoining areas , who then created awareness among citizens about Swachh Survekshan, segregation and disposal of Dry and Wet waste, hazards of improper waste disposal, Composting, use of Swachhata-MoHUA App etc. They were accompanied by Faculties, Health Inspector and MSWs of Dept. of Community Medicine and concerned PCMC officials. Photographs were taken and information about participating citizens, Faculties and students were recorded in the format. There was active participation from the local residents and found the training sessions very informative.

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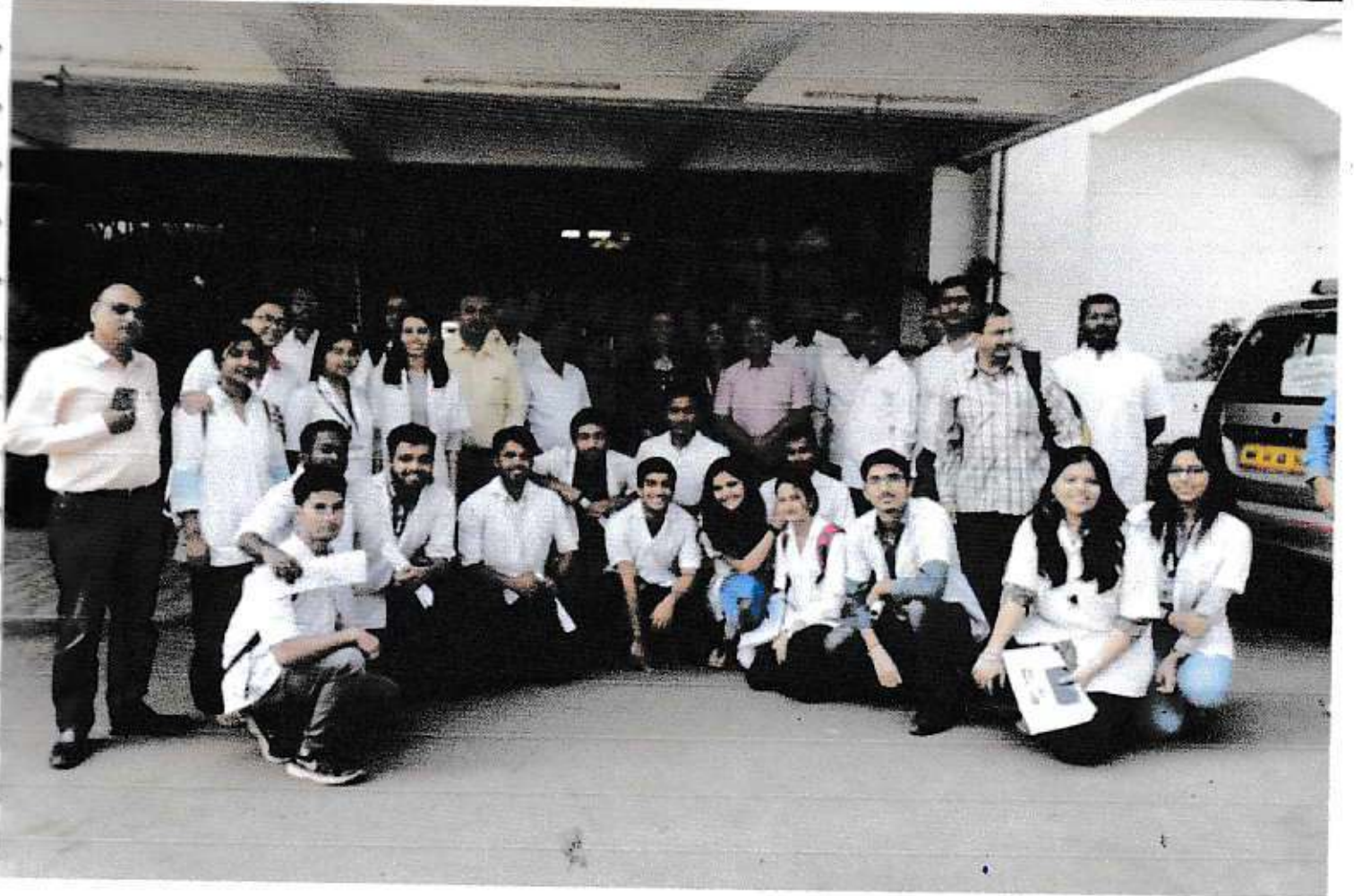




Figure _____ Swachhata survekshana, Kalamboli (Miss Vineeta Sharma & Students)

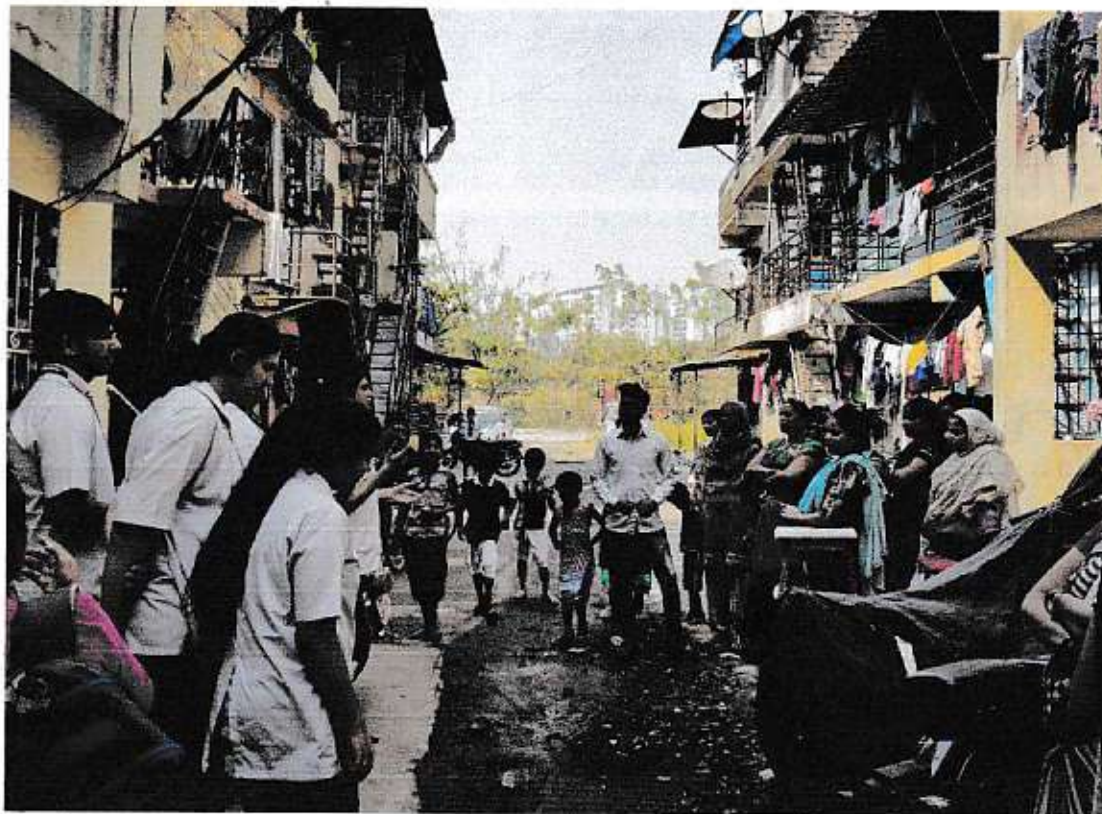


Figure ____ Sewachhta SURvekshana, Kalamboli (Dr.Seema Anjenaya & Students)



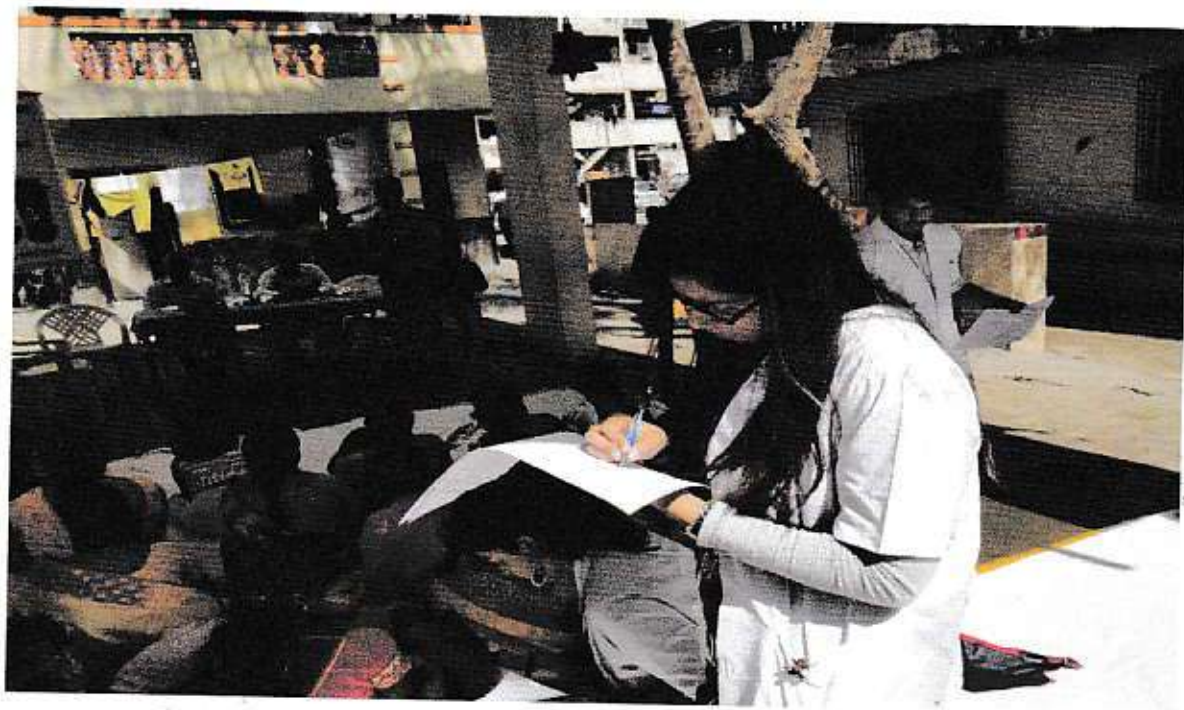

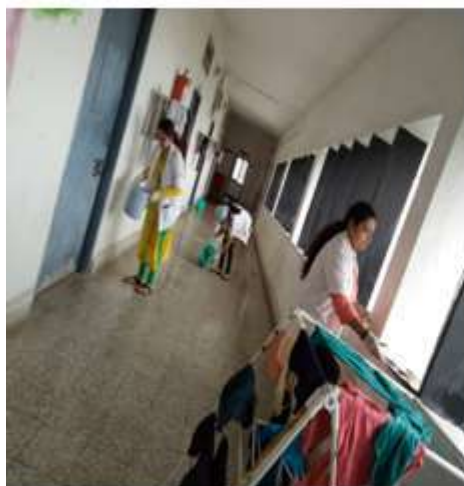

MORE is a super market which comprises of household products and grocery. They have got many franchises all over Aurangabad to provide easy accessibility to their customers. They are known for their quality products and hygiene of the store.



We have made a visit to one of their store to know about their waste disposal management. There the store manager provided us information about their waste management. He gave us a tour of the store. We could observe that there was different group for housekeeping. We had a talk with this group and they told us that they are divided into three sub groups, one for sanitation second for grooming and last for the waste disposal. So we requested them to tell us more about the cleanliness of their store.

The housekeeping group showed us the three different dustbins with a special colour code for each and the board telling information about each of them. They told us that one of the groups is allotted for waste segregation every morning from the store. The second group will then be separating the waste according to the colour codes of the bins. And the last group will finally be dumping the waste into a large bin provided by Municipal Corporation separately. The further being dump by the Municipal corporation members.

To maintain cleanliness for the complete day they have kept dustbins all around the store at different places. Also the sweeping is done thrice a day by the housekeeping.

The waste water, waste from AC ducts and any spoiled liquid material has a different way of disposal. There are draining ducts at the backyard of the store where this liquid is being drained.

The toilet facilities for staff members as well as for customers are made separately for men and women. The cleanliness there is also maintained properly.

So our conclusion from the visit was the MORE store has got a proper waste management and disposal.

Day 1 1st September - Clean Campus Day

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Day 2 2nd September - Clean Hostel Day

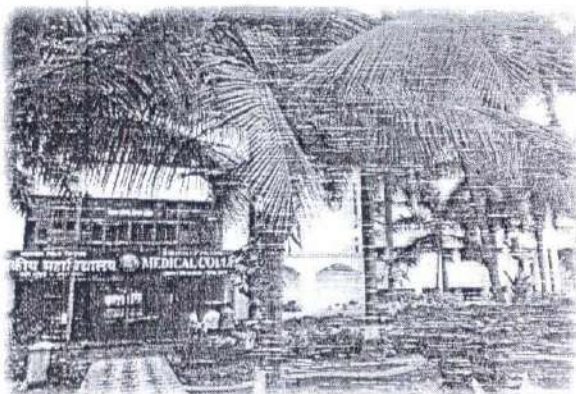

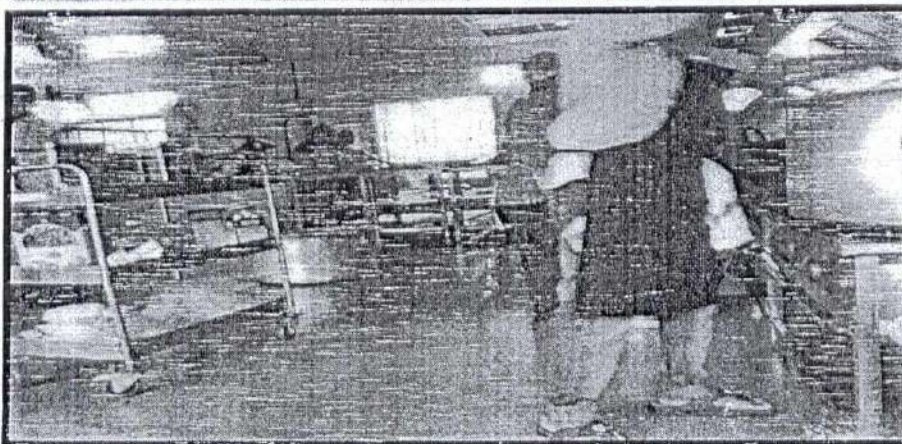


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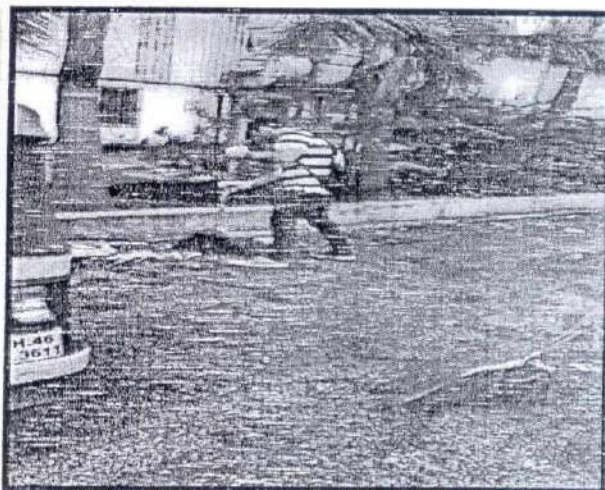
Day 5 5th September - Clean Mess Day

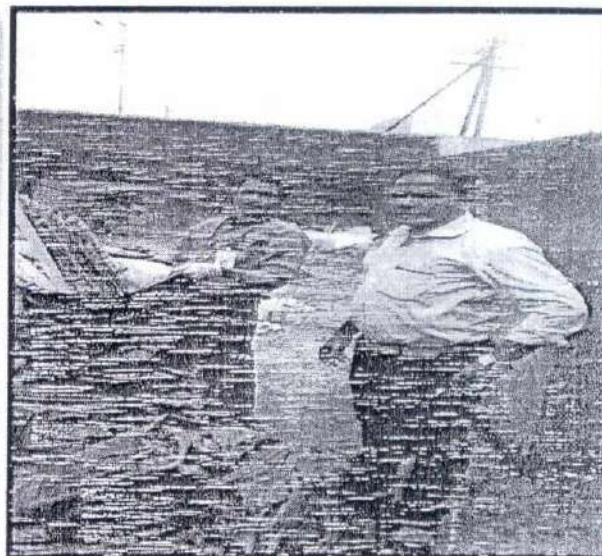
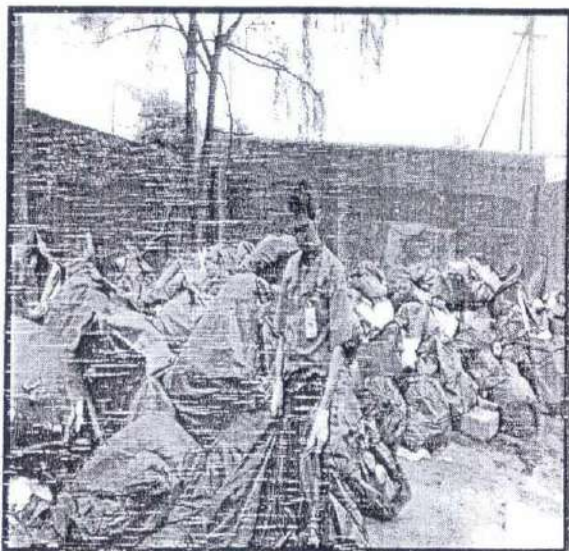

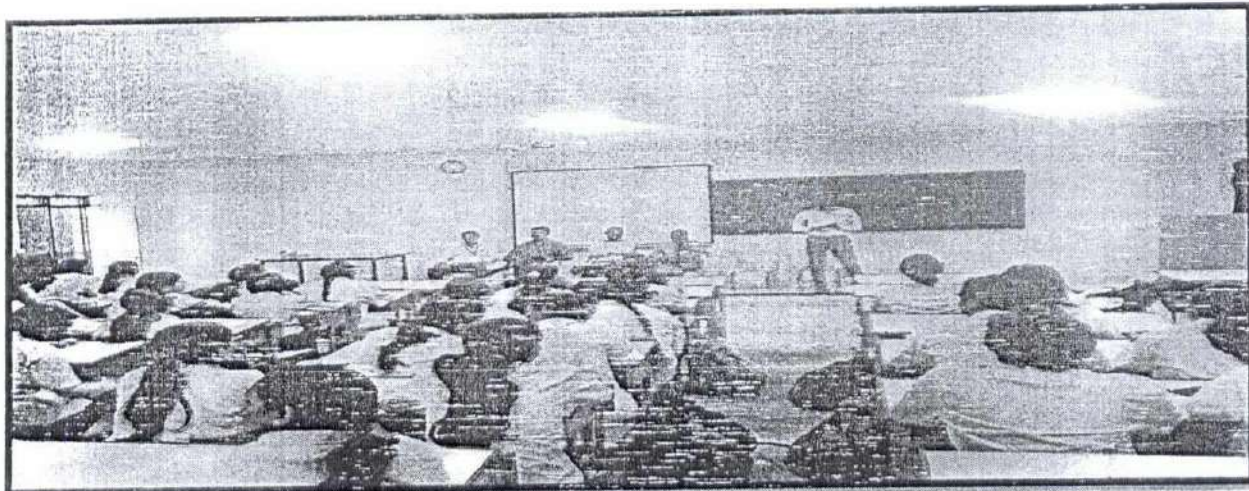
Day 6 7th September - Care for the Surrounding area: Cleaning of Dumping ground area

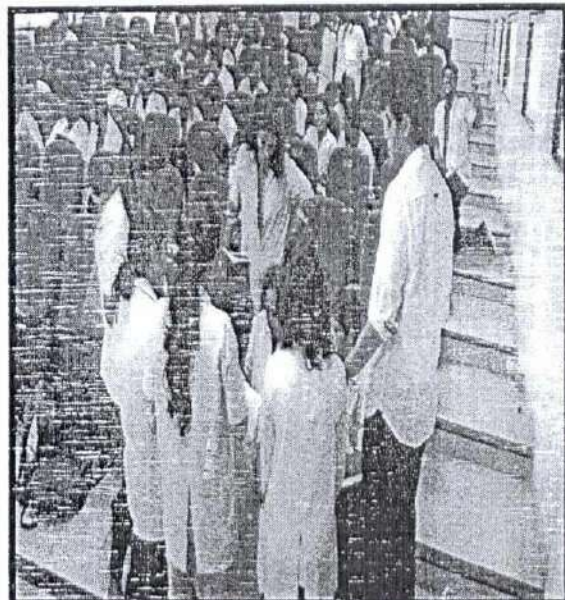
Day 7 8th September - An Awareness Talk on Biomedical Waste Management

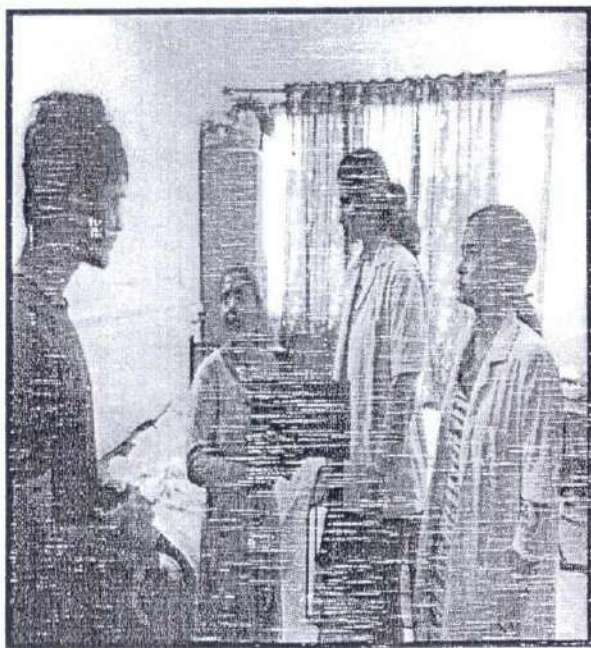
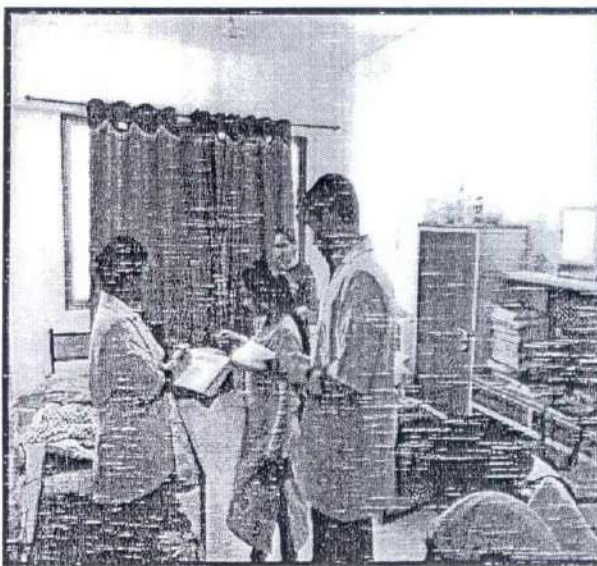
Day 8 9th September - Essay contest on “ Innovative ways for spreading the message of hygiene”

Street Play- Clean India awareness

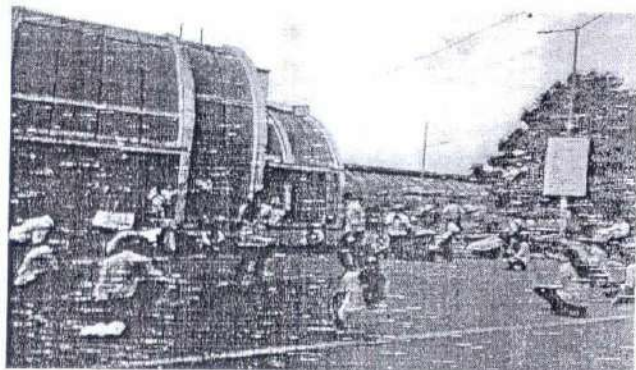
- A clean India awareness programme was conducted on 13.9.2017 between 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.

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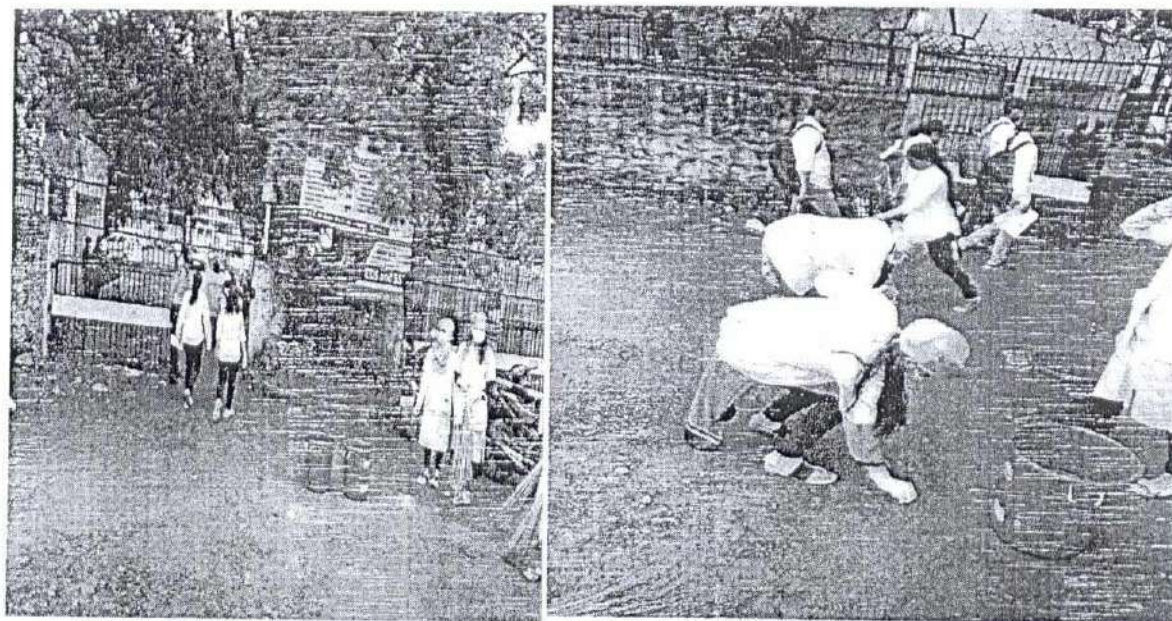
5. "Eassy Competitions"

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MORE is a super market which comprises of household products and grocery. They have got many franchises all over Aurangabad to provide easy accessibility to their customers. They are known for their quality products and hygiene of the store.



We have made a visit to one of their store to know about their waste disposal management. There the store manager provided us information about their waste management. He gave us a tour of the store. We could observe that there was different group for housekeeping. We had a talk with this group and they told us that they are divided into three sub groups, one for sanitation second

for grooming and last for the waste disposal. So we requested them to tell us more about the cleanliness of their store.

The housekeeping group showed us the three different dustbins with a special colour code for each and the board telling information about each of them. They told us that one of the groups is allotted for waste segregation every morning from the store. The second group will then be separating the waste according to the colour codes of the bins. And the last group will finally be dumping the waste into a large bin provided by Municipal Corporation separately. The further being dump by the Municipal corporation members.

The toilet facilities for staff members as well as for customers are made separately for men and women. The cleanliness there is also maintained properly.

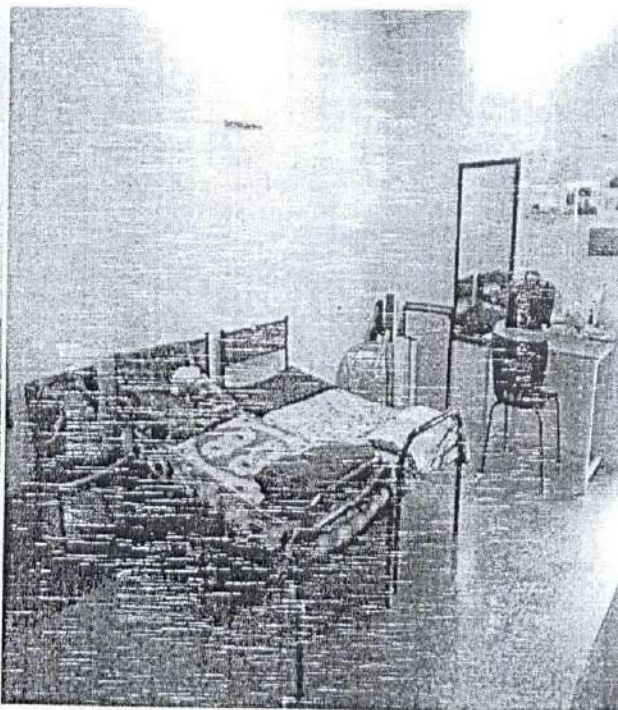
So our conclusion from the visit was the MORE store has got a proper waste management and disposal.

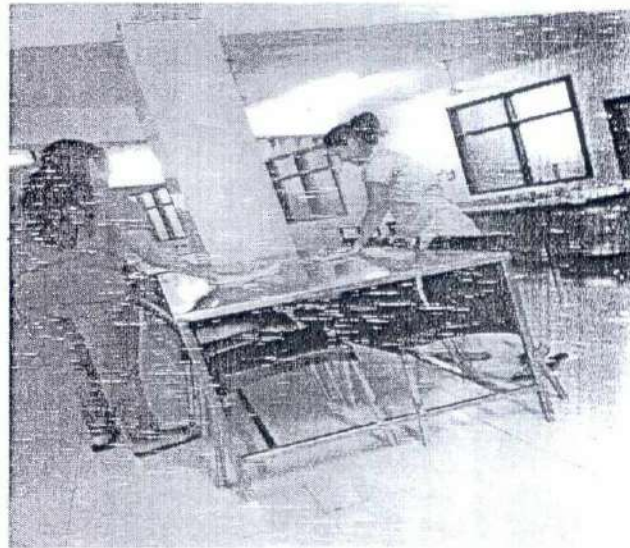
Report on Swachhata Pakhwada

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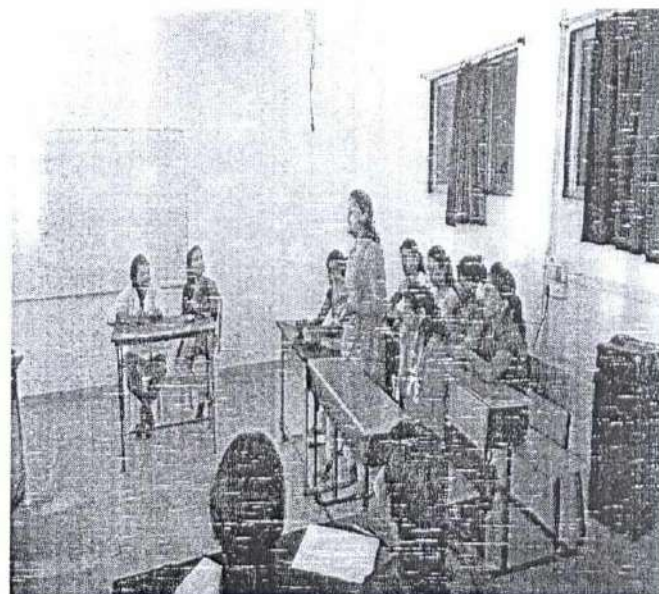
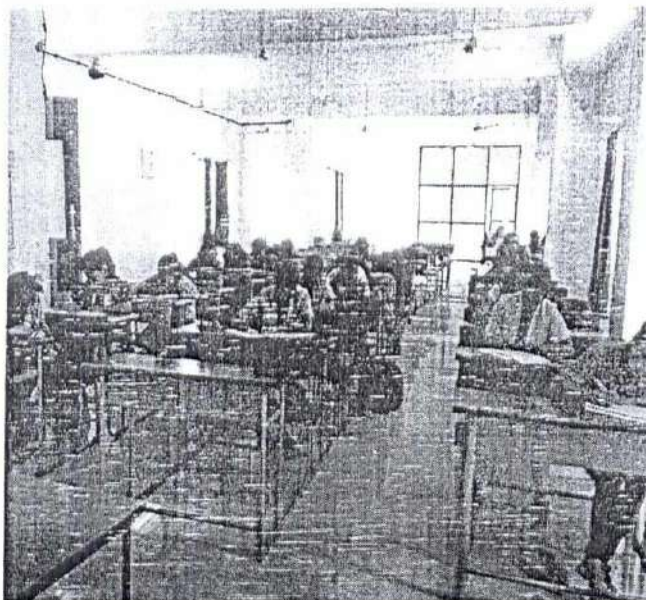


DAY 2
