
COURSE OUTCOME

<i>Level 1</i> Diagnostic laparoscopy Tubal patency tests Sterilization
<i>Level 2</i> Minor adhesiolysis Ectopic pregnancy Mild endometriosis Cystectomy Salpingo-oophorectomy Tubectomy LAVH without significant associated pathology Sub-total hysterectomy without significant associated pathology
<i>Level 3</i> Myomectomy Major adhesiolysis with associated pathology Total laparoscopic hysterectomy Endometriosis (stage III and IV) Incontinence procedures Suspension procedures
